Mr Jenkins has been heavily involved in working with the UK government on developing leadership programmes, to promote better mental health in the workplace. He was named among HR Magazine UK's Most Influential Thinkers in 2014 and 2016.

Over the past nine years, Mr Jenkins has successfully led Roffey Park through a series of challenges and expansion phases. Prior to that, Mr Jenkins was CEO of CCL Asia Pacific where he started up the organisation's operations in Asia from Singapore. Over a period of four years, Mr Jenkins grew the business significantly, building from scratch a strong team of talented professionals and associates, while achieving significant business growth. Before CCL, Mr Jenkins spent five years at INSEAD, in France and subsequently in Singapore, where he was responsible for strengthening and developing the executive education business, and significantly expanding its footprint into China, Japan, India and Malaysia.
